Develop criteria for your product/outcome

Now that I have collected a wide variety of sources and evaluated these and highlighted the sections that I will use to inform the creating of my Photography BlogSpot, I need to create specifications that will help me know when I have achieved my goal. This will also provide me with a guide as to how best achieve my goal.

How will I know when I have achieved my goal?

I will know when I have achieved my Personal Project goal when I have 8 of my photographs uploaded to my BlogSpot site.

- 2 of these photographs will show my developed understanding of the photography element of perspective.
- 2 of these photographs will show my developed understanding of the photography element of composition.
- 2 of these photographs will show my developed understanding of the photography element of lighting.
- 2 of these photographs will show my developed understanding of the photography element of colour balance.

How can I judge the quality of my product/outcome?

I can judge the quality of my Photography BlogSpot by assessing how my photography skill in these four elements has developed from my research and then practising by applying this research.

I will also ask photographer and my primary source Kirran Shah to look at my images and provide feedback.

Aesthetics	As my goal is to create a Photography BlogSpot that allows viewers to appreciate the aesthetic nature of photography, my photographs and my BlogSpot will need to be aesthetically pleasing.
Cost	As I already own the camera equipment, I do not need to purchase the camera equipment and my BlogSpot will be a free site, there will be no additional cost.
Customer	The client/target audience of my project will primarily be people who are interested in photography and enjoy browsing the internet and reading photography blogs. I will need to make sure my BlogSpot is accessible to all and aesthetically appealing so it can catch the eye of amateur photographers such as myself.

Resources	The resources that are available to me are my camera, a Nikon D30, tripod, MacBook Pro and the Parap Markets.
Environment Considerations	I have initially planned on creating a photobook, however, in order to be a good global citizen I have chosen to create a photo BlogSpot so I will not have to use paper and printing products.
Function	My Photography BlogSpot must be accessible on multiple laptops and devices, e.g., iPhones, Galaxy, etc. It must be aesthetically pleasing and easy to view. The images will need to inspire people to visit the Parap Markets.
Size	The images on my Photography BlogSpot need to be 1MB – 1.5MB in size so they can be clear, but also not too large to be difficult for the BlogSpot page to load.

After considering these specifications and revising my goal statement, global context selection and research I have come up with a list of 5 specifications achievable specifications:

1. My Photography BlogSpot must have 8 images that capture the colour and activity of the Parap Markets.
2. My Photographs need to demonstrate my developing understanding and application of the photography elements of perspective, composition, colour balance and lighting.
3. My BlogSpot must be aesthetically pleasing and easy to view by having lots of white space surrounding the images.
4. My photograph headings need to be simple and descriptive.
5. My Photography BlogSpot needs to reflect the colourful and multicultural characteristics of Darwin.

I have shown my supervisor these specifications and they have approved that yes, these are very thorough and rigorous specifications that are achievable for me.

Criteria for success

I now need to transfer these specifications to the criteria for success in my report graphic organiser so that as I progress through creating my product/outcome I can continually self-assess and improve. I will also use this rubric to give my personal final grade that I can use for my reflection.
